PCA AGENCY PROVIDER

- Option of Minnesota Personal Care Assistance Program
- Allows patients receiving PCA Services to choose the agency that hires trains and supervises their PCA

Our Personal Care Assistance (PCA) services provide assistance and support for persons with disabilities, living independently in the community. This includes the elderly and others with special health care needs.

Our train individuals come into your home and assists you with your activities of daily living. Some of which include:

- Assistance with activities of Daily Living
- Bathing/Dressing, and Toileting Assistance
- Light Housekeeping
- Meal Preparation
- Medication Reminders
- Component and Personal Care



Our Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) provides services with disabilities and persons age 65 and older in any county in the state, subject to the standards of Minnesota Statue, Chapter 245A and Minnesota Status, 245D.

The HCBS services address the needs of people with functional limitations who need assistance with everyday activities. The program enables people to stay in their homes rather than moving to a facility for care.
